WILDLIFE RESOURCE CENTER \$10,000

AWLA's Wildlife Resource Center provides education, outreach, and emergency field response for wildlife. It also supports a network of skilled rehabilitation partners with the lifesaving supplies they need, subsidies for training, and a corps of volunteer drivers to transport wildlife where it needs to go. Each year, the Wildlife Resource Center responds to more than 3,000 calls for wildlife services, from helping orphaned baby squirrels to injured deer. As stewards for all animals in our community, AWLA is committed to fostering the harmonious coexistence between humans and native wildlife through conservation efforts, respect for the environment, tolerance and understanding for all living things, and humane approaches to resolving wildlife conflicts. Sponsors ensure that wildlife and rehabilitators have the support they need to thrive.







KITTEN COLLEGE

\$15,000

AWLA's Kitten College is a nationally recognized program designed to save the lives of neonatal kittens from unnecessary euthanasia at area shelters and rescues due to lack of resources. The strength of AWLA's Kitten College is its foster network. It is made up of dedicated volunteers of all skill levels who care for kittens ranging in age from days to months old with supplies, training, and support provided by the shelter. AWLA also offers free apprenticeships to shelter and rescue staff all over the country to equip them with the knowledge and skills to establish their own kitten colleges. Sponsors provide medical care, supplies, and support to make sure that the shelter's most vulnerable population can become its most adoptable.







COMMUNITY CARE CLINICS \$10,000

AWLA offers clinics that provide affordable veterinary care, vaccines, microchips, and pet supplies to members of our community. Working in partnership with local nonprofits and government agencies, AWLA endeavors to meet pet owners on their terms, in their languages, at times and locations convenient them. Sponsors provide vaccines, microchips, pet food, supplies, and preventatives so that anyone may know the love of a pet.





PET PANTRY

\$10,000

AWLA operates a pantry for pet owners to obtain pet food, and supplies for free with the goal of keeping owned-pets happy, healthy, and home with the people who love them. Demand for this program is high and we sometimes have to turn clients away when our cupboards are bare. Sponsors provide food and supplies for thousands of pets in our community so no one goes hungry.





VETERINARY ASSISTANCE GRANTS \$10,000

AWLA's Veterinary Assistance grants provide financial assistance for qualified pet owners to obtain life-saving emergency veterinary attention for their animals, thus preventing unnecessary suffering and keeping pets in homes and out of shelters. Sponsors ensure that owned pets get treatment when they need it most.





HOUSING EMERGENCY LIFELINE \$10,000

Through the Housing Emergency Lifeline Program (HELP), AWLA provides temporary housing for pets belonging to residents of Arlington and Falls Church City who are experiencing a health or housing crisis. Sponsors can make the difference between someone being able to keep and care for their pet and having to surrender it.





PAWS & READ

\$15,000

AWLA's free Paws & Read program offers children and young teens (through age 14) the opportunity to read to adoptable cats and small companion animals at the shelter. Young readers can improve their skills in the company of nonjudgmental shelter animals and in turn socialize and soothe shelter pets with the sound of their voices. Sponsors enable shelter pets and local kids to share comfort and build confidence.



PAWS & BREATHE

\$15,000

AWLA's Paws & Breathe program supports the well-being of people and shelter pets with opportunities to slow down, relax, and enjoy the calming effects of being together. Doing yoga with kittens, meditating with rabbits, or just snuggling with puppies reduces anxiety and stress, naturally. And it helps to socialize shelter pets so they become comfortable with handling, different voices, and new environments. Sponsors provide people and shelter pets with an opportunity to rest, restore, and just BE for a little while.





SUMMER CAMP

\$10,000

AWLA's summer camps are a fun way to inspire compassion and respect for animals. The camp curriculum incorporates animal-themed crafts and games into daily lessons. Kids ages 6-13 get in-person opportunities to learn about companion animal behavior, care, and handling from guest speakers and shelter staff on site at AWLA.
